

Comanche Central Appraisal District is accepting résumés for an Appraiser

This position is responsible for office and fieldwork associated with the discovery, inspection, data collection, analysis & application of generally accepted appraisal techniques for all property in which the District has jurisdiction. The ideal applicant must be a team player, self-motivated, detail oriented, able to work under pressure and adapt to periods of increased workloads.

They must have a high school diploma or GED, good math skills, be capable of walking in various types of terrain and climates and hold a valid Texas driver's license with an acceptable driving record.

A Registered Professional Appraiser license is required, or they must start working toward the RPA designation with TDLR. This requires attending 10 courses out of town for up to 5 days at a time and taking 2 state exams over a 3-5 year period.
